HUMAN RIGHTS CODE AMENDMENTS — The Conservative government has introduced a Bill in the Ontario Legislature to amend the Human Rights Code. As promised by Bill Davis himself, gays aren's covered by the changes. The Bill will now go before a committee which will hold hearings at which the public will be invited to express their points of view. If you as an individual feel that you would like to appear before the committee, contact Jim - 822——. Otherwise, we suggest that you write to your MPP (see last newsletter for addresses) and state your support for the inclusion of the gay minority among those protected from discrimination by the Ontario Human Rights Code. If we don't act now it will be several years before we have this opportunity again.
