

Coming Out

Early in 1985, I wrote a coming out letter to my brother. I have just recently received a reply (about eight months later). I am including a portion of the letter here because it is of value to anyone involved in social reform.

"What I wish to say Cheryl, is We have been given more potential to do good within this world than many will ever know. We will be subject to numerous abuses along our paths, but we will have the wisdom to adjust our courses so that we suffer minimal setbacks.

In as much as we will have to fight(work) for what we believe to be right, we must avoid antagonism. The best way to remove an enemy, is to make him or her a friend. Patience and sensitivity are key components in this process as every person we encounter is unique and therefore must be dealt with differently. (To "FIGHT FOR WHAT WE BELIEVE IN..." However, "Avoiding antagonism" might be more appropriately called "WORK!")

Be direct. State (speak) your truth quietly and clearly! (Desiderata)

"and listen to others, even the dull and ignorant: they too have their story."

keep in mind that you can do more good working for your cause without interuption, than you can in isolation. (i.e. in jail)
