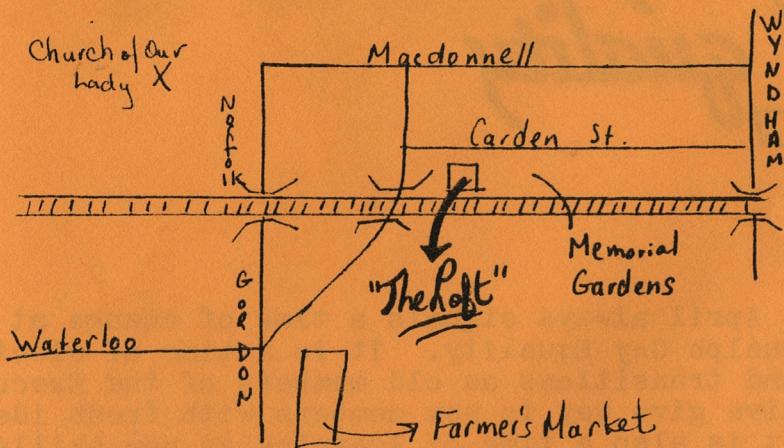
I would also like to thank Cheryl for the good job she did as Manager of the Navy Club Dances. Best of luck in Toronto.
