Digitized Files - JPEG Version: The JPEG version is of **lower quality** than the PDF version, but will generally be **faster to download** than the PDF version. If your Internet download speed is lower, then this is a better option than the PDF version.

Digitized Files - PDF Version: The PDF version is of **higher quality** than the JPEG version, but generally takes **longer to download** than the JPEG version. After the file is displayed, we suggest that you **set your viewing window as large as possible** and then **adjust the PDF magnification** so that the text can be read comfortably.



Kelly & the Kellygirls

HIGH-ENERGY, ska-tinged swinging showstoppers could be fairly used to describe the sound of Kelly and the Kellygirls. The sevenpiece Toronto-based Canadian group encompasses many different sounds but are usually found playing swing venues in Toronto.

A sexy spectacle of glam, swing, ska, and theatrics. Kelly Clipperton, lead singer and founder of the Kellygirls, lights up the stage with a great energy: and his raucous but soft pitched voice contrasts with the bouncy band which includes a horn section.

Highly entertaining, fashionably versatile and always amusing, R.Kelly Clipperton and his band Kelly and the Kellygirls unleashed the the black and blue bawdy burlesque of their sophomore album We love you, but not as Much as we love Ourselves in May 2006. a follow-up to 2004's 'swing swing'. The band completed a 27 date Canadian tour in the fall of 2006. followed by a Western Tour and UK Tour in the summer of 2007 with amazing reviews and audiences across the board.

Clipperton - though no stranger to the cycle of smug self-absorption takes care (unlike so many) to look beyond the mirror. We Love You,

But Not As Much As We Love Ourselves is a manic, theatrically charged paean to the crash and burn of desire in all its messy glory. In a modern twist of mischievous revelry. Clipperton, whose voice fiendishly croaks somewhere between Peter Murphy and Tim Curry, at times channels lan Dury in sheer sweat-soaked bluster if not precise sonic gusto: the band create both a joyous and painful rumble, its subversive, ska-tinged swinging showstoppers soaring sky-high one second, only to wallow in the gutter with bitter bravado the next.






already having a repertoire of over 35 songs including both covers and originals, Kate & Moxy are ready for any type of stage from large to small, and intimate to concert settings.





OTE'A TANE

(oteh-ah tah-neh) ...

Literally means a group dance that is performed with unity (ote'a) by men (tane). In unity, Ote'a Tane seeks to preserve and illustrate the beautiful culture of Tahiti and Hawaii that is rarely experienced here in Canada through dance.

Organized as a not for profit troupe of male dancers specializing in performing the Tahitian ori and the Hawaiian hula in the ancient style makes Ote'a Tane very rare even in Polynesia. Ote'a Tane is the only one of its kind in Ontario and probably Canada as a whole. Since 2004, Ote'a Tane has mesmerized and inspired audiences of all ages and from diverse cultural backgrounds to appreciate the beauty of ancient Polynesia through dances performed exclusively by men, just as it was in ancient

Polynesia - in the spirit of Ote'a Tane.

Ote'a Tane is an all male Polynesian group, specializing in the Tahitian ote'a and hula kahiko (ancient hula). The group's mission is best summarized by the Lesbian & Gay Community Appeal Foundation when they described their cultural initiative as:

"Ote'a Tane engages gay men from the community in learning and performing traditional Polynesian and Hawaiian dance. Through our performances Ote'a Tane provides the opportunity to break down barriers and challenge stereotypes while providing a social outlet and support."

Ote'a Tane is "an all-male, all-gay hula group," says choreographer Ramon Lara. "We perform authentic traditional hula." But where's the coconut bras and grass skirts? "That's exactly the stereotype we're trying to change!" he laughs. "In ancient Hawaii, it was the guys who performed the real hula movements. which are very athletic." Back then. Lara says, "there was no stigmatization of different sexual relationships...Hawaiians didn't question how nature expressed itself."

Performing Sundays at the Wellesley Community Centre. Ote'a Tane "reaches out to other communities," says Lara. "The basic pose is straight back, bent knees, pride and strength, which is our message, really. Pride and courage."
