

Together with Kyra Crilly (cello/viola/melodica), Jacob Mouka (vocals/guitar) and Ozzie Saunds (percussion), Theo is passionate about writing and sharing honest, compelling songs that reflect the human experience.

Beyond the Mountain's first single, "This Old River," was released on iTunes in the fall of 2012. In the same year, they won "Best Singer-Songwriter" and "Best Song" at Toronto's Indie Week. They have also performed at Canadian Music Week, the Royal Ontario Museum's Friday Night Music Series, the Songwriters Association of Canada's AGM, and many other events. In 2013, the band opened for Brian Wilson at the prestigious Teddy Bear Affair charity gala; shared a stage with The Fugitives, White Ash Falls, The Most Loyal and other musicians at famed Toronto venues such as Lee's Palace and the Rivoli; and organized a successful fundraiser for survivors of Typhoan Haiyan. In December, Beyond the Mountain headlined at the Rivoli, playing a special Christmas show to a packed house.

Since the spring of 2013, Beyond the Mountain has hosted a popular weekly band night ("Velvety Tuesdays") to cultivate and promote the music scene in Toronto's east end.

Beyond the Mountain is currently in the studio recording an EP of original songs Pop, Disco, Motown, R&B, and Grammy Winning Legend...

Ms. Thelma Houston

A Mississippi native, Thelma started out in the 60's performing in gospel music with the Art Reynolds Singers. She then signed to Capitol Records (home of the Beatles, Nat King Cole and Nancy Wilson) in 1967 and had her first hit song called "Baby Mine."



After 44 years of performing, Thelma Houston continues to celebrate her long and outstanding career and shows no signs of slowing down!!

Soon Thelma was courted by several record labels and signed with ABC/Dunhill where she recorded and released her first solo album called "Sunshower" which was written, arranged and produced by the legendary limmy Webb. After this critically acclaimed album was released, Thelma decided to accept an offer from one of the biggest record companies around, Motown Records.

With Motown Records, Thelma daimed the top of the Pop, R&B and Dance charts with her high-powered rendition of "Don't Leave Me This Way". That Gold Record classic gave Thelma the distinction of being the first solo female artist at Motown to win the Grammy Award for "Best R&B Female Vocal Performance"

Thelma was honored to perform on Fox's #1 rated show American Idol, where she toreit up for an estimated audience of over 25 million people. Shortly after, Thelma was called to open up the finale of the hit summer show, NBC's America's Got Talent, for an estimated TV audience of over 18 million people.

With appearances from Tokyo to Las Vegas to Londonand beyond, Thelma continues to bring audiences to their feet with her dynamic, energetic show. This Diva logs over 200 performances annually and the singer/songwriter is enjoying every moment of her success. "I still feel a tremendous excitement about performing," states the upbeat songstress. "I have so many more things I want to do and I have NO plans to retire. Thelma's makes hermain home in Los Angeles, CA.
